

1. An abstract is a concise summary of your research work, with a clear understanding of your study's purpose, methodology, results, and significance within 150–300 words (unless specified).
2. A soft copy of the payment receipt with transaction ID must be attached with the abstract.
3. Abstract must be original, not under review elsewhere, and plagiarism must be below 10%
4. For English use font Times New Roman, font size 12, bold headings and single spacing.
5. For Marathi and Hindi, use Unicode font, size 14.
6. Author details must include Name (s) of author and co-author, designation, Institution and affiliation, email and Mobile Number
7. The abstract should follow this format: Title, author Name (s), Abstract, key words, Introduction, Literature Review, Research work, Conclusion and References
8. Scholarship that bridges ancient wisdom with modern challenges.




## HOW TO REACH YCMOU
