
### Summary of Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on Curriculum Development, Pedagogy & Assessment





Most of the participates are teachers.


#### 3. Rate the overall quality of the session:

• The overall quality of the session received a highly positive response, with 68.6% of participants rating it as Excellent. However, 31.4% rated it as Average.




#### 4. How would you rate the presenters' knowledge and delivery?

 The presenters demonstrated a strong command of the subject, with 78.4% rating their knowledge and delivery as excellent, while 21.6% found it average.




#### 5. How would you rate the overall content of the session?

• The overall content of the session was highly appreciated by participants, with 70.3% rating it as excellent (5)




#### 6. Was the workshop content aligned with your expectations?

7. Was the speaker(s) approachable and responsive to participant queries?


 The speaker(s) were highly approachable and responsive, with 100% of participants affirming their engagement and ability to address queries effectively.


#### 8. Registration process:

 The registration process was highly satisfactory, with 83.8% rating it as excellent and 16.2% as good, indicating an overall positive experience. No participants rated it as average.




#### 9. Venue and facilities:

and 11.1% rating them as good. This reflects a well-organized event with a comfortable and wellequipped setting that met participants' needs effectively.




## 11. Quality of workshop materials (handouts, slides, etc.):

 The quality of workshop materials, including handouts and slides, was highly rated by participants, with 75% rating them as excellent and 25% as good.




#### 12. Time management during the sessions:

 Time management during the sessions was highly effective, with 73% of participants rating it as excellent and 27% as good.




## 13. How likely are you to recommend this workshop to others?
