## SUBJECT: Credit Transfer Policy

The University has adopted credit transfer policy to recognise the learner's previous attempts to pursue education. The learners attempt to pursue a degree program or complete diploma program. However due to their professional and family responsibilities or financial constraints, fail to complete the same and feel that their effects are wasted and they could not now pursue education. In order to help such learners and appreciate their efforts and enable them benefit from their previous education, the University has formulated the credit transfer policy.

Under this policy, the learners:

1. Who have completed a diploma program in a particular discipline can get admission to the second year of the degree programme of the same discipline.

2. Who have taken admission to a degree programme of conventional University completed the first year of the program of that University successfully but could not pursue the studies of second and third year can get admission directly to the second year Degree program of the same discipline.

The University has also developed a system to accommodate and benefit maximum numbers of learners who can be benefited by completing a program of the university. The thought process begins right from the concept and development proposal of a new program. The schools while putting a proposal for a new program before the school Council and Academic council give complete thought as to how we can accommodate learners by giving them the facility of credit transfer and help them to achieve vertical mobility in education and life.
