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Usability ICT Based Worker Course for Professional Development of Students

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Abstract

Twenty first Century peoples are using Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in various fields. Government of India started for Digitization of various activities. People required different ICT skills for doing various activities. These ICT skills are developed through various types of Programme.

Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University (YCMOU) is mega Open University having one objective "To provide an innovative, Flexible and Open System of education by using the distance teaching methodology and by applying modern communication technologies to education". YCMOU having eight Schools in which one School is School of Education. It started e-B.Ed. Programme in 2009 as a pilot study. University expected learner from various fields. Since learners were lacking in ICT Skills, the dropout rate was high. The Nomenclature of the Programme is now changed to Post Graduate Diploma in E-Education in Digital Society (PGDEEDs). YCMOU in collaboration with MKCL is offering this programme. In service Teacher (Primary to University Level), Jobseekers, Peoples from Non Government Organisation(NGO), Parents have taken admission for this programme. This time, to avoid the dropout rate because of lacking in ICT skills, one additional ICT Worker Based Course is introduced as the first course to the students of the programme. This Course is given online to the students using their unique user id and password.

The course has 20 sessions. Around 50-60 % students have completed this course; while 40 % students have not yet started or had competed very few sessions. They are facing difficulties. The Presenter took feedback from the students for usability of the course and difficulties faced by them. Most of the students are using these ICT Skills in their day to day work; their professional skills are increased.
