Child Education: A Review of Indian Researches

Abstract

Educational research is mainly associated with syllabus, learning teaching process, students, evaluation, teachers, their expertise and parameters essential for effective education etc. It must be considered that education policy should be based on research. This is clear from the National Education Policy of 1986.

The abstract of education research is published after the survey is done. Till now five surveys are done and their abstract are available in seven different volumes. These volumes have released abstract of approximately 6,425 different education researches. Among them only 144 researches are done on child education. It means only 2.24% research is done on child education. The first research on child education was done in 1957. It is seen that research field is as neglected as the child education field. With such a small percent of research on child education how will the issues of child education, their solutions, different experiments, information, conclusion etc. will reach the people who work in this field? Who can imagine the comprehensiveness of research on child education? Where will the inspiration come from? Many such questions arise.

What is the situation of Indian research on child education? Based on the conclusion received we can brain storm, seek solutions and contribute qualitatively in child education by focusing on process for child education, training programs for child educators, various thought perspectives of child in child education etc.

Few criterions were used while presenting the research conclusions. Teaching learning process related to child education, learning process, psychological study, society, linguistic and physical development, parents, school, teacher's role and their effects. The Study of Education Research was thought for children in the age group of 0 to 6 years; while they failed to focus on children above 6 years.

This research essay presents what should be the focus of all well acclaimed and experienced professionals with reference to child education i.e. improvement in child education, sustaining change and quality.

0.1 Research on child
